As Governor Scott has aligned with the CDC on May 14th, it's time to make policy changes to align with the government policies and move from spring to summer. Effective now, all POM customers and employees can follow these guidelines:

Fully vaccinated people (after 14 days after their last shot) DO NOT HAVE TO WEAR A MASK

Unvaccinated people (not fully vaccinated) must wear masks inside POM when in line to order, going to the restroom, or walking to or from the table. At the table, you do not have to wear a mask.

Governor's Scott's amendment to his Executive Order on page 3 states:

- (f) Masks or Cloth Facial Coverings.
 - <u>Fully Vaccinated People</u>. Effective immediately, fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a face covering over nose and mouth or physically distancing, except where required by federal, State or local laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.
 - For the purposes of this section, people are considered fully vaccinated for COVID-19 two weeks after they have received the second dose in a series of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or 2 weeks after they have received a single-dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
 - Unvaccinated People. Unvaccinated people are not required to wear face coverings over nose and mouth when they are in outdoor public spaces, provided sustained or prolonged close contact with other unvaccinated people from outside their household can be avoided.
